Lace a 'stick' person or animal. Size matters: The above adult is 5 inches tall. Your figure should fit into this scale e. g. a child should be smaller and a giraffe should be much taller.

It can be any color. The book suggested polyester sewing thread. I used quilting thread.

The figure needs to be lightly starched.

You can make one or as many as you like.

You may pin your figure(s) onto heavy paper and give it a "speaking bubble" on that paper and let it say something clever or funny (for display purposes only).

Entries will be numbered so the judges will not know the makers. If you submit several, your number will have A, B, C, etc added so judges know. Not more than one figure from one lacemaker can win.

First, second and third place winners will receive complimentary commemorative bobbin.

Entries will be displayed at the Heartland Lace Guild Exhibition and Demonstration during the Paducah Quilt Show in April 2010 at Grace Episcopal Church.

Visitors will be asked to vote for popular choice. First, second and third place winners will receive a complimentary commemorative bobbin. Multiple entries from one lacemaker will be grouped.

Entries will not be returned. After the exhibition I would like to make a wall hanging (size depending on number of entries). Ideally it should be big enough to raffle for a good cause like cancer research. Suggestions welcome!
